A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL RECORDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 622-57, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:

3 "(g) Reasonable costs incurred by a health care provider
4 in making copies of medical records shall be borne by the
5 requesting person[-]; provided that no copy costs shall be
6 charged to a patient, patient's attorney, or authorized
7 representative if the medical records are necessary to support a
8 claim or appeal under any provision of the Social Security Act,
9 title 42 United States Code section 301 et seq., or for state
10 assistance pursuant to section 346-52."

11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Medical Records; Social Security Act; Aid to the Aged, Blind, and Disabled Program

Description:

Mandates that medical providers provide medical records to a patient, patient's attorney, or authorized representative free of charge if the request is for the purposes of a claim or appeal under any provision of the Social Security Act or for state assistance under the aid to the aged, blind, and disabled program.

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
