# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL RECORDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 622-57, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:

3           "(g) Reasonable costs incurred by a health care provider  
4 in making copies of medical records shall be borne by the  
5 requesting person[-]; provided that health care providers may  
6 charge a flat fee of \$15.60, or the amount currently approved by  
7 the Social Security Administration, whichever amount is greater,  
8 to a patient for copies of medical records necessary to support  
9 a claim or appeal under any provision of the Social Security  
10 Act, title 42 United States Code section 301 et seq.; or may  
11 provide such records free of charge to a patient."

12           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Medical Records; Social Security Act

**Description:**

Allows health care providers to provide medical records to patients for a flat rate of \$15.60, or the amount currently approved by the Social Security Administration, whichever amount is greater, if the request is for the purposes of a claim or appeal under any provision of the Social Security Act; or for free. Effective July 1, 2050. (SB3012 HD1)
