## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC LAND.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 171-50, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:	
3	"(c) Legislative [disapproval.] approval. Any exchange of	
4	public land for private land shall be subject to [disapproval by	
5	the legislature by two thirds vote of either the senate or the	
6	house of representatives or] approval by majority vote of both	
7	houses of the legislature in any regular or special session	
8	following the date of the board of land and natural resources'	
9	approval in principle of the exchange. The state department or	
10	agency shall submit for introduction to the legislature a	
11	resolution for review of action on any exchange to be	
12	consummated by the board wherein exchange deeds will be executed	
13	by the parties together with the following information:	
14	(1) The specific location and size in square feet or in	
15	other precise measure of the parcels of land to be	
16	exchanged;	
17	(2) The value of the lands to be conveyed by the State and	
18	the private party;	

1	(3)	The name or names of the appraiser or appraisers;	
2	(4)	The date of the appraisal valuation;	
3	(5)	The purpose for which the lands are being exchanged;	
4	(6)	A detailed summary of any development plans for the	
5		land to be exchanged; and	
6	(7)	A statement of whether the land is, or is not, land	
7		that was classed as government or crown lands previous	
8		to August 15, 1895, or was acquired by the State in	
9		exchange for such lands, and a detailed explanation of	
10		how the state department or agency made this	
11	·	determination.	
12	A co	py of the draft resolution shall also be submitted to	
13	the office	e of Hawaiian affairs at least three months prior to	
14	the convening of a regular or special session of the legislature		
15	to allow the office to determine whether the land was classed as		
16	government or crown lands previous to August 15, 1895, or was		
17	acquired by the State in exchange for such lands."		
18	SECT	ION 2. Section 171-50.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
19	amended to read as follows:		
20	"§17:	1-50.2 Exchanges for conversion of leasehold lands to	
21	fee simple	e ownership. The board may exchange public lands for	
22	private la	ands to be condemned or involuntarily sold pursuant to	

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- 1 chapter 516. [Such] An exchange shall be requested by the
- 2 executive director of the Hawaii housing finance and development
- 3 corporation [-7] and shall be effected in conformity with section
- 4 171-50; provided that [such] an exchange shall be subject to
- 5 legislative [disapproval;] approval; provided further that the
- 6 private lands conveyed to the State shall be disposed of
- 7 pursuant to chapter 516; and provided further that lands
- 8 exchanged need not be of like-kind or comparable use; provided
- 9 further that no lands classified as conservation shall be
- 10 exchanged for private lands."
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
