 20 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
 21 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
 22 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective

3 expended by the appropriate expending agency for the purposes of
4 this Act.
