
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VIDEOCONFERENCING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and to read
3 as follows:

4 **"PART II. COMMITTEE HEARINGS, GENERALLY**

5 **§21- Videoconferencing; rules.** Each chamber of the
6 legislature shall establish, by rule, procedures to enable
7 neighbor island residents to present oral testimony at
8 legislative committee hearings through the use of audiovisual
9 technology."

10 SECTION 2. Chapter 21 is amended by designating sections
11 21-1 to 21-19 as part I, entitled "Investigating Committees,
12 General Powers; Sergeant-at Arms".

13 SECTION 3. Section 21-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 **"§21-1 Purpose.** The purpose of this [~~chapter~~] part is to
16 establish procedures governing legislative investigating
17 committees to provide for the creation and operation of
18 legislative investigating committees in a manner [~~which~~] that



1 will enable them to perform properly the powers and duties
2 vested in them, including the conduct of hearings, in a fair and
3 impartial manner, consistent with protection of the
4 constitutional rights of persons called to testify at such
5 hearings and preservation of the public good."

6 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
9 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
10 2014-2015 for establishing audiovisual technology throughout the
11 State to enable neighbor island residents to present oral
12 testimony at legislative committee hearings.

13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
14 of accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
