A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VICTIM RESTITUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to expand the
2 definition of "victim" to include insurance companies for the
3 purposes of criminal restitution orders.

4 SECTION 2. Section 706-646, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:

6 "(1) As used in this section, "victim" includes any of the
7 following:

- 8 (a) The direct victim of a crime including a business
9 entity, trust, or governmental entity;
- 10 (b) If the victim dies as a result of the crime, a
11 surviving relative of the victim as defined in chapter
12 351; or
- 13 (c) A governmental entity or an insurance company that has
14 reimbursed the victim for losses arising as a result
15 of the crime or paid for medical care provided to the
16 victim as a result of the crime."

17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
