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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 84-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

3           "(d) The financial disclosure statements of the following  
4 persons shall be public records and available for inspection and  
5 duplication:

6           (1) The governor, the lieutenant governor, the members of  
7 the legislature, candidates for and delegates to the  
8 constitutional convention, the trustees of the office  
9 of Hawaiian affairs, and candidates for state elective  
10 offices;

11          (2) The directors of the state departments and their  
12 deputies, regardless of the titles by which the  
13 foregoing persons are designated; provided that with  
14 respect to the department of the attorney general, the  
15 foregoing shall apply only to the attorney general and  
16 the first deputy attorney general;

17          (3) The administrative director of the State;



1           (4) The members of the board of regents, the president,  
2           the vice presidents, the assistant vice presidents,  
3           the chancellors, and the provosts of the University of  
4           Hawaii;

5           (5) The members of the board of education and the  
6           superintendent, the deputy superintendent, the state  
7           librarian, and the deputy state librarian of the  
8           department of education;

9           (6) The administrative director and the deputy director of  
10          the courts; [~~and~~]

11          (7) The administrator and the assistant administrator of  
12          the office of Hawaiian affairs [~~-~~]; and

13          (8) The members of the following boards and commissions:

14           (A) The board of agriculture;

15           (B) The board of land and natural resources;

16           (C) The Hawaii labor relations board;

17           (D) The Hawaiian homes commission;

18           (E) The labor and industrial relations appeals board;

19           and

20           (F) The public utilities commission."

21          SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
22          and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
