5 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
6 be as follows:

7 "Shall each person's right to a clean and healthful
8 environment be based on mutual respect and justice for all
9 and the State's commitment to environmental justice and the
10 fair treatment of populations that may be
11 disproportionately affected by proposed actions on the
12 health and environment of those populations?"

13 SECTION 4. Constitutional material to be repealed is
14 bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
15 underscored.

16 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
17 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
18 the State of Hawaii.
