A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE IMPERSONATION OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 710-1016.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[+]§710-1016.6[+] **Impersonating a law enforcement officer**
4 **in the first degree.** (1) A person commits the offense of
5 impersonating a law enforcement officer in the first degree if,
6 with intent to deceive, the person pretends to be a law
7 enforcement officer, and [~~is armed with a firearm.~~]:

8 (a) is armed with a firearm;

9 (b) intentionally or knowingly causes another person to
10 apprehend a harmful or offensive contact;

11 (c) threatens violence to another person by an immediate
12 show of force;

13 (d) threatens or attempts to confiscate or damage property
14 of another person; or,

15 (e) threatens or attempts to exercise dominion or control
16 over another person.




1 (2) Impersonating a law enforcement officer in the first

3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
