# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE LIBRARIAN.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 312-2.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 **"§312-2.1 Appointment of state librarian; duties; salary.**

4 (a) The state librarian shall be appointed by the [~~board of~~  
5 ~~education~~] governor and with the advice and consent of the  
6 senate, without regard to chapter 76, shall be under the  
7 direction of the [~~board~~] governor, shall be responsible for the  
8 operation, planning, programming, and budgeting of all  
9 community/school and public libraries within the State, and may  
10 be removed by a majority vote of [~~its members~~] the legislature.

11 The state librarian may be appointed:

12 (1) Without regard to the state residency provisions of  
13 section 78-1(b); and

14 (2) For a term of up to four years.

15 (b) The salary of the state librarian shall be set by the  
16 [~~board of education~~] legislature at a rate no greater than  
17 \$120,000 a year.




1 (c) The state librarian may appoint, without regard to  
2 chapter 76, one secretary for the state librarian. The  
3 secretary for the state librarian shall serve at the pleasure of  
4 the state librarian."

5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
