A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow charter
2 schools that offer adult and community education programs to
3 charge a course fee.


4 SECTION 2. Section 302D-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by amending subsection (h) to read as follows:

6 "(h) No charter school may assess tuition[-]; provided
7 that a charter school that offers adult and community education
8 programs equivalent to the types of programs listed under
9 section 302A-433 may charge a course fee as approved by the
10 advisory council for adult and community education established
11 pursuant to section 302A-434."


12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
