A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTIONS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-7.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[+]§11-7.5[+] Duties of the elections commission. The
4 duties of the elections commission are to:

5 (1) Hold public hearings;

6 (2) Investigate and hold hearings for receiving evidence
7 of any violations and complaints;

8 (3) Adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91;

9 (4) Employ, without regard to chapter 76, a full-time
10 chief election officer, pursuant to section 11-1.6;
11 [and]

12 (5) Provide oversight of the chief election officer; and

13 ~~(5)~~ (6) Advise the chief election officer on matters
14 relating to elections."

15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
