# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1.   Section 386-80, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "§386-80 Examination by impartial physician.   The director  
4 of labor and industrial relations may appoint a duly qualified  
5 impartial physician, whose specialty is appropriate for the  
6 injury being examined, to examine the injured employee and to  
7 report.   The fees for such examination shall be paid from the  
8 funds appropriated by the legislature for the use of the  
9 department of labor and industrial relations."

10           SECTION 2.   New statutory material is underscored.

11           SECTION 3.   This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
