S.B. NO. 903

A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

PART I

SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the sources of funding indicated below to program planning, analysis, and budgeting (BUF 101) the following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to fund for fiscal biennium 2013-2015 all collective bargaining cost items in the collective bargaining agreement negotiated with the exclusive bargaining representative of collective bargaining unit (8):

18 SECTION 13. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
 19 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
 20 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
 21 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
 22 from the respective funds.



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1 SECTION 14. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
2 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2014, and June
3 30, 2015, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of
4 those dates.

5 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
