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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the  
3 sources of funding indicated below to program planning,  
4 analysis, and budgeting (BUF 101) the following sums, or so much  
5 thereof as may be necessary, to fund for fiscal biennium  
6 2013-2015 all collective bargaining cost items in the collective  
7 bargaining agreement negotiated with the exclusive bargaining  
8 representative of collective bargaining unit (8):

21 SECTION 13. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided  
22 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is



1 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other  
2 funds, shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may  
3 be, from the respective funds.

4 SECTION 14. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act  
5 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2014, and June  
6 30, 2015, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of  
7 those dates.

8 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
