Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 1374, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PROCUREMENT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to reduce unnecessary spending in state government by:

- (1) Allowing the past performance of a bidder to be factored into the selection of a contractor, including a review of delays, cost overruns, corrective actions, and responses to notices of deficiencies; and
- (2) Requiring assessments of prior work in the selection of a contractor.


