Your Committees on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian
Affairs and Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1616 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH PLANNING,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to improve health outcomes for
the people of Hawaii by updating the Hawaii State Planning Act's
objectives for health to include a commitment to eliminating
health disparities. Specifically, this bill updates the
objectives to:

- (1) Explicitly address social determinants of health to
reflect the latest medical findings relating to the
health needs of Native Hawaiians, other Pacific
Islanders, and Filipinos; and
- (2) Prioritize programs, services, interventions, and
activities that address identified social determinants
of health to reduce health disparities experienced by
these groups.

The Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Office of Language Access,
Office of Community Services, Community Alliance for Mental
Health, United Self Help, Hawaii Primary Care Association, Kokua
Kalihi Valley, Waimanalo Health Center, Hoola Lahui Hawaii, The
Queen's Health Systems, HealthyPacific.Org, and several
individuals provided testimony in support of this measure.



Your Committees respectfully request that subsequent committees consider inserting a funding mechanism to enable the implementation of this measure.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian Affairs and Health that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 1616 and recommend that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Economic Development & Business.


