"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION,"

The purpose of this measure is to improve the post-secondary education system in Hawaii by:

- (1) Eliminating profitability as a factor that can be used by a private college or university to demonstrate financial integrity for purposes of authorization to operate in the State; and
- (2) Repealing the State Post-secondary Education
  Commission's authority over procedures for receiving and
  responding to complaints concerning institutions of
  higher education in the State, since the Department of
  Commerce and Consumer Affairs was granted that authority
  pursuant to Act 180, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013.

The Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and a concerned individual supported the measure. The University of Hawaii submitted comments.

No. 2142 and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
