The purpose of this measure is to enable the public to
compare health insurance premiums by requiring, upon request, all
managed care plans to provide health insurance premium information
to the Insurance Commissioner, who shall publish it annually on
the insurance division's official website.

The Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Hawaii
Medical Service Association, Hawaii Primary Care Association,
Community Alliance for Mental Health, United Self Help, and a
concerned individual supported this bill.


Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2050, to
facilitate discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the
purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.
