Your Committee on Energy & Environmental Protection, to which
was referred H.B. No. 2509 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO ASSIST
COMMUNITIES WITH THE REMOVAL OF MOTOR VEHICLE TIRES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to assist
communities affected by discarded or abandoned tires by providing
funds for the removal from the landscape of abandoned tires.

The Hawaii Automotive Dealers Association and an individual
testified in support of this measure. The Department of Health
commented on this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by clarifying that
funding be used for programs promoting removal from the landscape
of abandoned tires that have been illegally dumped, including
funding county programs established pursuant to Chapter 342I,
Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Should the House Committee on Finance deliberate on this
measure, your Committee respectfully requests its consideration of
the appropriation amount of \$250,000.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Energy & Environmental Protection that is attached to
this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and
