Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 834
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR
COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to make emergency
appropriations to fund all collective bargaining cost items for
salary increases and other wage related costs in the arbitrated
settlement for members of collective bargaining unit (11) and
their excluded counterparts.

Pursuant to the requirements set forth in Article VII,
Section 9, of the Hawaii State Constitution, the Governor, in his
Governor's Message No. 213 to the Legislature, requested immediate
consideration and passage of this bill by the Legislature to fund
all collective bargaining cost items for salary increases and
other wage related costs in the arbitrated settlement for members
of collective bargaining unit (11) and their excluded
counterparts.


The Department of Budget and Finance and Hawaii Fire Fighters
