"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF
EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO ASSIST WITH
INCREASING VOTER REGISTRATION AMONG YOUNG ADULTS, "

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to increase the rate of voter
participation by young people in Hawaii by requesting:


- (1) The Department of Education and Department of Human
Services to assist with increasing voter registration
among young adults;
- (2) The Department of Education to provide high school
seniors at every public school with voter registration
information prior to graduation;
- (3) The Department of Human Services to provide young adults
in young adult voluntary foster care with information on
voter registration; and
- (4) The Department of Human Services to provide
informational literature about the voter-registration
process to any young adult who inquires.



The Department of Education, Office of Elections, Department of Human Services, and Hawaii Youth Services Network supported this measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Human Services that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 43 and recommends its adoption.
