entitled:

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to support mandatory
kindergarten.

Your Committee distributed a proposed draft of this measure
in order to conduct a public hearing on its substance. As
proposed, this measure urges the United States to support the
Republic of China's (Taiwan) participation in the Trans-Pacific
Partnership.

Your Committee has amended this concurrent resolution by:

- (1) Replacing its contents with the provisions of the
proposed draft, that would urge the United States to support
the Republic of China's (Taiwan) participation in the Trans-
Pacific Partnership;
- (2) Amending its title to read: "URGING THE UNITED STATES TO
SUPPORT THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA'S (TAIWAN) PARTICIPATION IN THE
TRANS-PACIFIC PARTNERSHIP"; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 52, as amended herein, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto as H.R. No. 52, H.D. 1.
