Your Committee on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian
Affairs, to which was referred H.R. No. 86 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND
NATURAL RESOURCES TO REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE ON THE STATUS
OF EACH MARINE LIFE CONSERVATION DISTRICT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of
Land and Natural Resources to submit a report to the Legislature
no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular
Session of 2015 on the status of each marine life conservation
district in the State, including:

- (1) An evaluation of whether the marine life conservation
program is achieving its intended purpose, both as a
whole and with respect to each marine life conservation
district;
- (2) A determination of whether any of the marine life
conservation districts should be modified, and if so,
how; and
- (3) An explanation of why past reports regarding the marine
life conservation districts have not been submitted to
the Legislature.



The Department of Land and Natural Resources, The Nature Conservancy, and an individual provided testimony in support of this measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 86 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Finance.
