Your Committee on Health, to which was referred S.B. No. 2045
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE COLORECTAL CANCER
SCREENING PILOT PROGRAM,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to:

- (1) Establish a Hawaii colorectal cancer screening awareness
pilot program using the Hawaii comprehensive breast and
cervical cancer control program as a model; and
- (2) Appropriate funds for the first year of the pilot
program.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Health, American Cancer Society, The
Queen's Health Systems, and six individuals.


Your Committee finds that colorectal cancer, often referred
to as colon cancer, is a dangerous and deadly cancer that affects
approximately nine hundred people in Hawaii each year. Your
Committee further finds that a screening program for colorectal
cancer will increase detections of cancers at an early state,
improving chances for survival and decreasing mortality rates.



Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2045, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2045, S.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
