Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred  
S.B. No. 3036, S.D. 2, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO BEACH MANAGEMENT FOR THE NORTH  
SHORE OF OAHU,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to address erosion on Oahu's  
North Shore by requiring the University of Hawaii Sea Grant  
College Program to create a North Shore Beach Management Plan for  
the area stretching from the Kawailoa to Waialeale ahupuaa and  
appropriating funds for the development of the plan.

The University of Hawaii Sea Grant College Program,  
Department of Design and Construction of the City and County of  
Honolulu, Surf Rider Foundation, and numerous concerned individuals  
testified in support of this measure. The Department of Land and  
Natural Resources supported the intent of this bill.


Your Committee respectfully requests that the Committee on
