Madam:

Your Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental and
Military Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 965 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL
LICENSING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to establish
qualifications for nonresident military spouses eligible for
expedited procedures for professional and vocational licensing by
endorsement or reciprocity, and temporary licensing.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Professional and Vocational Licensing Division of the
Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and The Chamber of
Commerce of Hawaii. Your Committee received comments on this
measure from the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of
Defense.

Your Committee finds many spouses accompany their service
member spouse on military duty assignments. This measure
simplifies and expedites the employment of trained, educated, and
highly qualified military spouses while establishing requirements
for nonresident military spouses to maintain licenses and requires
reporting of changes in status or circumstances that may affect
licensure.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
