Madam:

Your Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental and
Military Affairs, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 8 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY
OF HONOLULU TO NAME THE NEW CENTRAL OAHU AMBULANCE FACILITY
AFTER THE LATE LORETTA FUDDY, DIRECTOR OF HEALTH,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to name the new
Central Oahu Ambulance Facility after the late Loretta Fuddy,
Director of Health.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Health and one individual.

Your Committee finds that as the Director of Health, the late
Loretta Fuddy was a highly respected national figure on health
services and public health administration. One of her first acts
as the Director of Health was to save the Maui County Medvac
helicopter from budget cuts. On December 11, 2013, that same
helicopter carried her body and the survivors of a commuter plane
crash off the Kalaupapa peninsula for further medical treatment.
Director Fuddy was killed in the line of duty while serving some
of the most abandoned and marginalized people of Hawaii. This
measure honors Director Fuddy's commitment to public service and
public health.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental and Military Affairs
that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the
