Your Committee on Health, to which was referred S.R. No. 109
entitled:

"SENATE RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO
ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY SERVICES PATIENT ADVOCATE PROGRAM TO
PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO AND ADVOCATE ON BEHALF OF PATIENTS
RECEIVING EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to encourage the
Department of Health to establish an emergency services patient
advocate program to provide assistance to and advocate on behalf
of patients receiving emergency medical services and their
families.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Community Alliance for Mental Health and two individuals.
Your Committee received comments on this measure from the
Department of Health.

Your Committee finds that sick and vulnerable patients and
their family members can become overwhelmed during a medical
emergency. Many patients are unaware of their rights regarding
the treatment and care they receive from their emergency room
physicians. Your Committee finds that many patients or their
family members may disagree with the diagnosis or treatment plan
provided by their emergency room physician but feel forced to
accept the treatment plan because they are unaware of how to
effectively exercise their right to secure appropriate and
available emergency medical care. As a result, your Committee

encourages the Department of Health to establish an emergency services patient advocate program to provide assistance to and advocate on behalf of patients receiving emergency medical services and their families.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.R. No. 109 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.


