SB3042 Status and Testimony	<u>RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSE CLASSES.</u> <u>Removes requirement that a class 14 brewpub licensee manufacture not more than thirty thousand barrels of malt beverages on the licensee's premises during the license year.</u> <u>Establishes a new class 18 liquor license class for small craft producer pubs. Makes conforming amendments relating to liquor license classes.</u>	<u>CPN/PSM, WAM</u> [Measure added on 2/6/2014]
