<u>SB 2279</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO ENERGY. Establishes a task force to study the feasibility of a photovoltaic waste recycling program.	ENE, WAM
<u>SB 2858</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION MANAGEMENT OFFICE. Establishes an Office of Environmental Information Management within the Department of Health. Effective July 1, 2014.	ENE, WAM
<u>SB 2931</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO RECYCLING. Amends the advance disposal fee for glass containers to a tiered structure based on the interior volume of the glass container.	ENE, WAM
<u>SB 2008</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER DEPOSIT SPECIAL FUND. Makes unspecified appropriation into the deposit beverage container deposit special fund.	ENE, WAM
<u>SB 2685</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE TIRES. Imposes a surcharge of \$1 per tire on any tire retailer or wholesaler who installs a replacement tire in the State after September 30, 2014. Repeals on 7/1/2019.	ENE, WAM
<u>SB 2683</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO ASSIST COMMUNITIES WITH THE REMOVAL OF MOTOR VEHICLE TIRES. Appropriates funds to assist communities affected by discarded or abandoned tires by providing funds for the administration of contracts to remove abandoned tires from the landscape.	ENE, WAM
<u>SB 2548</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO ELECTRICAL POWER GENERATORS. Requires certain diesel-powered electrical power generators to be equipped with diesel particulate filters that remove no less than 85% of the particulate matter.	ENE, CPN
