Establishes restrictions on transfers, sales, and deeds of property owned by the Hawaii Community Development Authority. Effective July 1, 2020.	WAL, FIN

Requires OHA to conduct a public hearing on any plan or proposal for any residential development in Kakaako prior to submission of the plan or proposal to the HCDA.

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING ON HAWAIIAN HOME OMH, HSG, FIN  
LANDS.

**Proposed HD3:** Extends sunset date of requirement that counties issue affordable housing credits for each residential unit developed by the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands.

PAPER: 2 copies (including an original) to Room 306 in the State Capitol;


FAX: For testimony less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islander without a computer to submit testimony through the website); or
