HB 2228
Status

RELATING TO THE HEARING DISABLED.
Requires the Department of Health to conduct a three-year pilot program on Hawaii Island to assist preschool-aged children with cochlear implants to acquire spoken language skills. Effective July 1, 2014.

RELATING TO FORENSIC MENTAL HEALTH.
Amends the penal code to establish limits on the length of conditional release for certain charges not involving violence, and to specify the circumstances under which the time limited conditional release may be tolled, as well as what happens if the time limited conditional release is revoked.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Testimony should indicate:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee(s) to which the comments are directed;
- The date and time of the hearing; and
- Measure number.

Electronic testimony will be accepted until the start of the hearing.



While every effort will be made to incorporate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.
