HB1713 (HSCR742-14) Status and Testimony	RELATING TO AGING. Appropriates general funds to provide ongoing financial support to healthy aging programs and services. Requires the Executive Office on Aging to conduct a public education and awareness campaign on long-term care and appropriates general funds for its support and evaluation. Effective July 1, 2014.	HMS, WAM
HB1841 HD1 (HSCR900-14) Status and Testimony	RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS. Establishes the Hale Kokua Program under the Housing First Program within the Department of Human Services to incentivize homeowners statewide to set aside dwelling units for rental by families or individuals classified as employed but homeless. Appropriates funds to the Housing First Special Fund for the Hale Kokua Program. Effective July 1, 2025. (HB1841 HD1)	HMS, WAM
