<u>HB 2250</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. Authorizes the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation Board of Directors to set the salary of the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation Executive Director.	HSG, LAB, FIN
<u>HB 2448</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. Allows the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation to issue bonds to eligible developers for infrastructure on land owned by the eligible developer for the construction of affordable housing.	HSG, FIN
<u>HB 2251</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HOUSING LOAN AND MORTGAGE PROGRAM. Increases the Hula Mae Multifamily Revenue Bond authorization amount.	HSG, FIN
<u>HB 2188</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO STATE FUNDS. Repeals the Waialua Loan and Subsidy Program, Kikala-Keokea Housing Revolving Fund, and Kikala-Keokea Infrastructure Development Fund.	HSG, FIN
<u>HB 2515</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT. Requires certification that all county and state highways that are or will be contiguous to the residential development are under construction as a condition to the issuance of certain permits.	HSG, TRN, FIN

RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS.
Requires condominium board members and managing agents to disclose potential conflicts of interest in the awarding of contracts. Requires annual report on complaints and enforcement actions. Grants the real estate commission enforcement powers over issues relating to the management of condominiums.

Status

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.
Prohibits smoking anywhere in a public housing project.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Testimony should indicate:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee(s) to which the comments are directed;
- The date and time of the hearing; and
- Measure number.

PAPER: Twenty copies (including an original) to Room 305 in the State Capitol;


