Status

RELATING TO HEALTH.  
Prohibits smoking in and around public housing projects and state low-income housing projects under the jurisdiction of the Hawaii public housing authority and in and around elder or elderly households.

SB 2265, SD1  
(SSCR2671)  
Status

RELATING TO HOUSING.  
Makes an appropriation to improve the existing public housing stock and increase the supply of public housing units in the State. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD1)

SB 2269, SD2  
(SSCR2710)  
Status

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.  
Authorizes the Hawaii public housing authority to establish a work study program with the University of Hawaii Myron B. Thompson school of social work and allow the work study program to be implemented at each public housing project and state low-income public housing project. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

SB 2542, SD1  
(SSCR2677)  
Status

RELATING TO THE DISPOSITION OF THE CONVEYANCE TAX COLLECTIONS TO THE RENTAL HOUSING TRUST FUND.  
Restores the allocation of conveyance tax collections to the rental housing trust fund to 50% beginning 7/1/2014. Effective 7/1/2050.

(SSCR2737)  
Status

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.  
Authorizes the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation Board of Directors to set the salary of the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation Executive Director; provided that the salary does not exceed a specified amount. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

(SSCR2462)  
Status

RELATING TO LOW-INCOME HOUSING.  
Authorizes the issuance and appropriation of general obligation bonds  
to fund low-income housing tax credit loans. Effective 07/01/2050.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

PAPER: Twenty copies (including an original) to Room 305 in the State Capitol;


