Appropriates funds for the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney of the City and County of Honolulu for the Career Criminal Prosecution Unit, Victim Witness Assistance Program, Veterans Court, Drug Court, and Hawaii's Opportunity Probation with Enforcement Program. <p><b><u>HB 2333, HD2</u></b> <a href="#">(HSCR829-14)</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a></p>	<p>RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE INTEGRATED SEX OFFENDER TREATMENT PROGRAM. Requires the Statewide Integrated Adult Sex Offender Treatment Program to employ a best practices philosophy for the treatment of adult sex offenders. Directs the Program to develop standards and guidelines for the assessment, evaluation, treatment, and supervision of adult sex offenders. RELATING TO JUVENILE JUSTICE.

PSM/JDL, WAM

Enhances the juvenile justice system by concentrating secure bed space on serious juvenile offenders. Strengthens disposition, adjustment, diversion, and services available for juvenile offenders to ensure family court judges, court staff, departmental staff, and service providers have the tools needed to keep youth safely and effectively in their communities. Increases interagency collaboration. Establishes a temporary Juvenile Justice Oversight Advisory Council. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB2490 HD2)
