HB 325 Status

RELATING TO SMOKING.

WAL/OMH, JUD

Prohibits smoking on all public beaches.

HB 1507

RELATING TO PUBLIC LAND.

WAL/OMH, FIN

Status

Amends the legislative approval requirement for any exchange of

public land for private land to require a majority vote in both houses.

HB 1537

RELATING TO CONSERVATION.

WAL/OMH, JUD

Status

Requires the DLNR to administer a permit program for grading and

grubbing within shoreline areas of the State. Establishes penalties.

HB 1544

RELATING TO ANIMALS.

WAL, JUD

Status

Allows restrained dogs in state parks in designated areas that have access to the shoreline; limits the State's liability. Authorizes the

DLNR to establish fines for violations.

HB 1519 Status

RELATING TO COUNTY ZONING FOR GROUP LIVING

WAL, FIN

FACILITIES.

Authorizes counties to require group living facilities to meet zoning requirements regarding traffic safety and congestion, elevated noise levels, and commercial deliveries. Defines geographic separation as at

least 2,000 feet.

HB 1120

RELATING TO LAND USE.

WAL, FIN

Status

Requires the office of planning to establish a detailed land

classification of overall (master) productivity ratings every 20 years,

beginning in 2014.

HB 1560

RELATING TO LAND USE.

WAL, JUD, FIN

Status

Requires the LUC to include, in conditional approvals of boundary changes, a date by which the boundary change is no longer valid if the

conditions have not been met.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
