<a href="#">HB 2277, HD1, SD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2910)</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO HEALTH CARE TRANSFORMATION. Establishes the Office of Health Care Transformation within the State Health Planning and Development Agency, and changes the agency's name to the Hawaii Health Care Planning and Policy Authority. Establishes the Health Care Transformation Special Fund. Extends from July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2017, the Health Care Transformation Program, which is temporarily placed within the Office of the Governor, and effective July 1, 2017, transfers the Health Care Transformation Program to the Hawaii Health Care Planning and Policy Authority. Appropriates funds. (SD1)	HTH, WAM
<a href="#">HB 2597, HD2</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2970)</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO TEACHERS. Authorizes under the teacher national board certification incentive program an additional per year bonus for teachers who maintain current national board certification and teach at a school in a focus, priority, or superintendent's zone. Deletes obsolete references. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB2597 HD2)	EDU, WAM
