HB2036	RELATING TO HEALTH. Requires the Department of Education to disseminate information, approved by the Department of Health, about human papillomavirus to the parents of students entering sixth grade.	EDN/HLT, FIN
HB2068	RELATING TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER PROGRAM. Requires DOH to replenish deficits in its deposit beverage container deposit special fund with its general fund balances under specified conditions.	EEP/HLT, FIN
HB2084	RELATING TO RECYCLABLE MATERIALS. Establishes a pilot program to accept for recycling products that are not easily recycled in Hawaii.	EEP/HLT, FIN
