## Thursday, January 23, 2014

The Senate of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2014, convened at 11:37 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators English and Keith-Agaran who were excused.

The President announced that she had read and approved the Journal of the Fourth Day.

At this time, Senator Espero introduced two supporters of S.B.
