- Department's Position: The Department of Health strongly supports the nomination of Mr. Eric A.
- 2 Okazaki to the Board of Certification of Public Water System Operators.

- 4 **Purpose and Justification:** Mr. Okazaki has thirty-three years of overall experience in the water
- 5 industry and is currently the Vice President of Operations at Pural Water Specialty Company, Inc. where
- 6 he has over fifteen years of experience in the management of operations of private water systems. Prior
- to his current position, Mr. Okazaki was the Water System Manager for 10 years at the County of Maui,
- 8 Department of Water Supply where he was responsible for managing all potable water from wells and
- 9 surface water sources.
- In addition, to his extensive public and private potable water experience, Mr. Okazaki possesses
- both a Distribution System Operator and a Water Treatment Plant Operator certification, both at the
