In consideration of **GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE 593** SUBMITTING FOR THE CONSIDERATION AND CONFIRMATION TO THE ISLAND BURIAL COUNCIL, ISLAND OF HAWAI'I, GUBERNATORIAL NOMINEE, T. KEIKIALOHA KEKIPI, FOR A TERM TO EXPIRE 6-30-2017

The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) supports Governor's Message 593, nominating Mr. T. Keikialoha Kekipi to the Island Burial Council, Island of Hawai'i to expire June 30, 2017.

The Island Burial Councils are established under Section 6E-43.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes. With regard to previously known burials, the Councils determine whether to leave the burial in place or remove it, recognize lineal and cultural descendants and provide counsel and advice to the Department.

Mr. Kekipi is a resident of Puna and is familiar with its families, practices, and protocols. He currently serves as the Executive Director of Ho'oulu Lahui, an educational 501c3 organization whose mission and goals are to perpetuate Hawaiian cultural practices and beliefs. Mr. Kekipi is also the President of the Kua O Ka La New Century Public Charter School Board in Puna. He is a member of the Council for Native Hawaiian Advancement and the Hawai'i Alliance for Community Based Economic Development.

Mr. Kekipi previously served on the Hawai'i Island Burial Council from 1994-2002. Senate confirmation will ensure that Mr. Kekipi's valuable knowledge and perspective informs the deliberations of the Island Burial Council until June 30, 2017.
