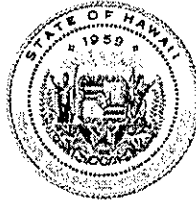
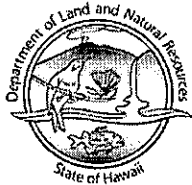
In consideration of

The HHFDC supports H.B. 2188, H.D. 1, to the extent that it applies to the Kikala-Keokea Housing Revolving Fund and the Waialua Loan and Subsidy Program. We defer to the Department of Land and Natural Resources with respect to Section 3 of this bill.
