The HHFDC **supports** Sections 3 through 6 of H.B. 2188, to the extent that they apply to the Kikala-Keokea Housing Revolving Fund and the Waialua Loan and Subsidy Program. We defer to the Department of Land and Natural Resources with respect to Section 2 of the bill, which references the Kikala-Keokea Infrastructure Development Fund.

HHFDC has no objections to the repeal of these funds. The Kikala-Keokea Housing Revolving Fund has no balance and no activity. The Waialua Loan and Subsidy Program similarly has largely fulfilled its purpose and has very little activity remaining.

Comments: The Hawaii Department of Land & Natural Resources (DLNR) plans to construct 7 recreational power boat mooring sites in Keauhou Bay costing taxpayers about \$616,000 projected costs. If DLNR's plan is approved Keauhou Bay might soon be restricted to power boats and prohibited to the countless swimmers, kayakers and paddlers who have long enjoyed this bay. Likewise, similar DLNR projects might be extended to many other bays throughout Hawaii. DLNR has already assigned these mooring sites to 7 very privileged recreational power boat owners whose connection with DLNR is open to speculation. DLNR's apparent preference for these 7 power boat owners versus everyone else is blatantly unfair and may explain why DLNR has done little to publicize this plan.
