The University, however, respectfully points out that we are not in a position to expand the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute system wide. The funding for the Institute was received from The Bernard Osher Foundation through a competitive endowment award based on demonstrated program success and evidence of sustainability specifically for the Institute at UH Mānoa.
