



SB2277 RELATING TO GOVERNMENT

The Administration of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) will recommend to the OHA Trustees a position of Comment on SB2277, which proposes to impose new requirements on agencies required by law or concurrent resolution to submit a report to the legislature.

Lines 12-17 on page 1 of the bill are somewhat ambiguous as to whether providing notice that it is unable to meet the deadline for a report financed by an appropriation, would enable the agency to avoid a possible budget reduction. We simply wish to call this ambiguity to your attention.
