BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 281, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, section

RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS OF ART

Senate Bill No. 2617 amends the criteria for the works of art to be commissioned to honor the late U.S. Senator Daniel K. Inouye and the late U.S. Representative Patsy T. Mink pursuant to Act 281, SLH 2013. The bill further amends the \$250,000 appropriation from the Works of Art Special Funds contained in Act 281, SLH 2013, to an appropriation of "an adequate sum" for FY 14 and FY 15 to commission the works of arts.

While the Department of Budget and Finance does not take any position on the commissioning for the works of arts, the department would like to point out that an appropriation of "an adequate sum" to reflect the cost for the commissioning of the works of arts is not valid. Appropriations need to specify an amount.
