This bill adds a new section to Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes regarding autoinjectable epinephrine.

HAJ opposes the immunity provisions set forth in this bill on page 3 and 4 in Section 1 (e). This provision provides immunity for an authorized entity, its employees, agents and other trained individuals. The provisions in this bill are broad in scope and the definition of "Authorized entity" on page 6 is much too broad to allow immunity for all those who are or could be involved with regard to epinephrine auto-injectors.
