I am Christopher Manfredi, President of the Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation (HFBF). Organized since 1948, the HFBF is comprised of 1,832 farm family members statewide, and serves as Hawaii's voice of agriculture to protect, advocate and advance the social, economic and educational interest of our diverse agricultural community.

**HFBF strongly supports SB 2679** which appropriates funds for the planning and designing phase II renovations to the Kamuela vacuum cooling plant.

Effective post harvest handling of produce is critical for maintaining product integrity between the farm and markets. Vacuum cooling is a proven effective means to increase the shelf life of wide variety of produce. A centralized facility in conjunction with a consolidation, deconsolidation, inspection, biosecurity facility provides a centralized and efficient service center for produce farmers in the Kamuela region.

The Kamuela Vacuum Cooling Plant is in need of improvements. The plantplant is decades old and the cooling equipment requires replacement. The Waimea area is the major producer of Hawaii-grown leafy green vegetables and peppers. Improving this facility will enable the continued production and consolidation of agricultural commodities from the Waimea region of the island of Hawaii.
